	ABOUT THE POSITION:	
Position Title:	Cantonese Translator	
Purpose of the position:	Provide Cantonese translation for people participating in a community program after being affected by a crime or incident. Victims, offenders and others in the Restorative Justice Program agree to take part in an alternative process to the court system to build together an agreement to repair the harm.	
Responsibilities & Activities:	Accept assignments to specific cases referred to the Program and must assist program participants with translation until the completion of the process. This includes all individual and group meeting that the participants must attend.	
Date/ Time / Shift of the event or activity:	Must be available either in the day or evening, or both, from Monday through Friday. (Most appointments occur in the evenings)	
Site location (place, indoors/ outdoors etc.):	Touchstone Family Association	
<b>Working conditions</b> (e.g. must be able to stand for a 5-hour shift):	Must be available to sit for the full duration of any meeting. Preliminary meetings can average 2 hours and group meetings can average 3 hours or more. (Most meetings average 2 hours.)	
Benefits to the volunteer:	Make your community safer and healthier Work in a safe, respectful and team environment Received education and training on restorative justice Build communication skills Receive additional training opportunities (First Aid, Crisis Prevention, etc.) Receive recognition for volunteer contribution	
Additional information about the position:	Translators will assist trained facilitators who have been assigned to the case and will work together to ensure that people who speak Cantonese can fully and fairly participate in a meeting or group discussion.
